Limited Re-Opening of the Calgary Flying Club

Good news everyone, we are back in business for Flight Training.

The Chief Medical Officer for Alberta has lifted provincial restrictions on flight schools. There will be certain protocols that we must follow so operations will be a little different but at least we will be flying. We plan to start up Monday June 1st using a staggered flying schedule (1/2-hour departures). The Club will be open on a reservation only basis to access the aircraft but the club lounge facilities will be closed. There will be a health questionnaire, a temperature check and of course, lots of hand sanitizer required prior to entering the Club. Masks will be required (we can provide - \$2) whenever we cannot stay 2 metres apart, i.e. in the aircraft.

Dispatch will be doing the initial assigning of students and instructors to planes to get us up and running again. Our priority will be contacting all previous students during the last week of May to setup your bookings. Aircraft rentals can continue to call in for bookings.

Unfortunately, the Club facilities will not be available for study or socializing as we must try to minimize the number of people in the building while maintaining social distancing. We do not expect ground school to resume before September.

We look forward to welcoming you back to the Club. Please continue to stay safe and healthy.
